

## **MAINE BASED ENVIRONMENTAL FELLOWSHIP APPLICATION- Summer 2025**

**Deadline: Tuesday, February 4, 2025 at 12:00 NOON**

The Environmental Studies Maine Based summer fellowships provide students with a 10-week funded placement in a local non-profit with the opportunity to address community issues while completing a project for the organization. All placements are at 40 hours per week from early June to mid-August. (Please note that during this time, students may not be employed by the College in any other position.)

The application includes a fellowship proposal and a resume (with two references) to be uploaded in one PDF document.

### **Fellowship Proposal**

Applications will be considered if a candidate has an internship offer already or if a candidate has solid ideas for their summer project. A student does not need to have all the details worked out at the time of submission.

The proposal should be 1–2-pages single-spaced and address the following: (1) a description of the experience you hope to gain in the environmental field through the fellowship; (2) possible
