

Guidelines for Double Counting Courses Between Majors/Minors

These guidelines apply through June 30, 2025. Starting in the 2025-2026 academic year, all students will be allowed to double count one approved course to two majors or between a major and a minor.

Africana Studies (AFRS)	Permission only	Permission only	Chair of Africana studies will work with student to discuss double counting cross-listed courses with other departments or programs
Anthropology (ANTH)	Unlimited	Unlimited	
Art: Art History (ARH)	1	1	Must be cross-listed with ARH
Art: Visual Art (VART)	Unlimited	Unlimited	Must be cross-listed with VART
Asian Studies (ASNS, CHIN, JPN)	1	1	
Biochemistry (BIOC)	Permission only	N/A	Biochemistry majors may not double major in chemistry, biology or neuroscience, and may only double count courses to a second major or a minor with permission of the biochemistry program
Biology (BIOL)	Electives only	Electives only	Electives for the biology major or minor may be double counted in a second department or program
Chemistry (CHEM)	2	Unlimited	
Cinema Studies (CINE)	N/A	1	
Classics (ARCH, CLAS, GRK, LATIN)	2	1	
Computer Science (CSCI)	1	0	
Earth & Oceanographic Science (EOS)	2	Unlimited	Students coordinating their EOS major with environmental studies may only double count two cross-listed courses; courses must be cross-listed with EOS
Economics (ECON)	Permission only	Permission only	The stats courses that count to the minor that are from outside ECON can double count to ECON
Education (EDUC)	2	2	Must be cross-listed with EDUC
English (ENGL)	3	1

Gender, Sexuality & Women's Studies (GSWS)	3	1	
German (GER)	1	1	Must be taught by a German faculty member and be pre-approved

Government & Legal Studies (GOV)	1	1	Must be crosslisted with GOV and must be taken at Bowdoin (not from study away or transfer credit)
History (HIST)	Unlimited	Unlimited	Must be crosslisted with HIST
