Student Designed Major Checklist

Student-Designed Major proposals are due no later than December 1 of a student's sophomore year. Students should review and follow the "Guidelines for Student-Designed Majors." Please include the items listed below when submitting your proposal to the Office of the Registrar.

1. Signed Student-Designed Major Checklist
2. Student-Designed Major proposal
3. Letters from Project Sponsors (normally two required) – Letters should include a) an evaluation of the student's program, b) an endorsement of the student and the major proposal and c) an indication whether the sponsor is the primary or secondary sponsor.

Student-Designed Major proposals automatically include a student transcript when submitted to the Curriculum Implementation Committee. Please indicate below if you give permission for student committee members to see your grades and GPA.
